not surprising that SimpleWeather (originally developed by waater.org) provides over 150,000 individual data series on more than 50,000 worldwide locations. Starting from the free version and continuing on to the latest paid version, SimpleWeather allows you to create your own personal weather map and locate the forecast at the first-click, without having to search for a specific station. Simply left-click on the System

Tray icon and you'll be able to display the current temperature, in addition to the current feels like, temperature change and wind speed. Weather conditions are shown in real-time, so you can see the forecast for the next five days and compare the weather forecast for various places. In addition to the ordinary weather map, SimpleWeather also provides a weather iconset, allowing you to switch to other weather

icon sets when necessary. Unfortunately, SimpleWeather is not very stable, even in the free version. What's more, the current location doesn't have a proper name and its search feature is quite limited. Although the forecast is very detailed, SimpleWeather can't show any colors and it doesn't include the weather icon sets.
